Automatic Number Plate Recognition System (ANPR)	Date: 07/11/2008

Policy Statement

The Civil Nuclear Constabulary (The Constabulary) will utilise the facilities and features of the ANPR system to gather, develop and act upon intelligence revealed by the system. This will provide an additional measure to prevent, detect and deter terrorist and other hostile activity in and around Civil Nuclear sites, and the movement of nuclear material.

In deploying the system The Constabulary will:

- Ensure a measured and proportionate approach is observed in its application, having due recourse to rights and freedoms of others in accordance with the European Convention on Human Rights, and the Human Rights Act 1998.
- Record the decision and rationale behind implementation of the ANPR system for any given situation.
- Have in place the required Regulation of Investigatory Powers Act authority (RIPA) when this is considered necessary.
- Ensure only properly trained and qualified personnel operate the ANPR systems.
- Ensure there are measures and safeguards in place to maintain the integrity and security of the equipment and data contained on the system.
- Ensure that the data contained on the system is up to date, relevant, properly maintained and stored.
- Ensure data information is only shared with approved organisations under the terms set out and agreed by the Constabulary in accordance with the Management of Police Information and the Data Protection Act.
- Comply with health and safety regulations including risk assessments with regard to the siting of vehicles deploying with ANPR, and the use of ANPR by drivers.

Aims of the Policy

To increase Public Safety through the pro-active use of the Automatic Number Plate Recognition System.

To manage the Constabulary's use of ANPR in a manner which guarantees its integrity and pays due regard to the rights and freedoms of others. This will be achieved through the provision of procedures and instructions documents which outline the rules for entering, accessing and safeguarding the data available through ANPR. These will

enable CNC authorised staff to use ANPR in support of their duties in law enforcement, national security and the protection of nuclear licensed sites and material.
