Policy Statement

The primary function of the Civil Nuclear Constabulary (CNC) is the protection of civil nuclear sites and nuclear materials. In providing this protection, the CNC needs to equip and train its Police Officers to meet the regulatory required standards and to meet the identified threat and risk assessments for the protection of those sites and nuclear material.

Based on the regulatory requirements and the threat and risk assessments, the CNC will, through its Vehicle User Group, determine the need for, and specification of, ballistically protected vehicles and arrange for their procurement (currently arrangements are through the CNC's membership of the Chiltern Transport Consortium).

An armoured vehicle is workplace equipment which meets certain specifications and is required for specific purposes. The CNC will therefore, as far as reasonably practicable, have processes and procedures in place for armoured vehicles in respect of:-

- their use;
- their maintenance;
- the driver training requirements.

Aims of the Policy

The aims of this policy are to ensure that the CNC assesses the requirements in relation to armoured vehicles and has processes and procedures in relation to their use.
