Policy Statement

The Civil Nuclear Constabulary (CNC) is not a categorised responder under the Civil Contingencies Act 2004 and therefore has no statutory requirement to demonstrate 'resilience' or to have business continuity plans. Nevertheless, the CNC will, as far as reasonably practicable, comply with legislation and apply national standards to ensure organisational resilience and the CNC Mission Statement are met and maintained whilst providing an appropriate operational response during a major incident or emergency event.

In addition to legal compliance and application of national standards, the CNC will endeavour to provide appropriate structures, plans and training together with processes and procedures for the guidance and development of its Police Officers and Police Staff to deliver effective business continuity. This will be managed through the CNC Business Continuity Management Governance Group and the CNC Contingencies Planning Officer.

Aims of the Policy

The aims of this Policy are to ensure, as far as reasonably possible that the CNC is able to meet and maintain organisational resilience whilst providing an appropriate operational response during a major incident or emergency event.
