## Policy Statement

The Civil Nuclear Constabulary (the Constabulary) is committed to making best use of its resources to ensure the protection of nuclear licensed sites and material, and to provide support for law enforcement and national security. The Constabulary will ensure that its officers and staff are able to undertake specific roles and functions in planning and managing an efficient and effective response to incidents.

To ensure this end the Constabulary will, as far as possible:-

- Provide training, guidance documents and opportunities through the exercise programme for officers and staff to carry out their roles and responsibilities appropriately when responding to incidents.
- Ensure a coordinated, structured response in line with national standards for managing and controlling incidents.
- Ensure that protocols and procedures are in place to enable effective interoperability with other police forces and agencies.

## Aims of the Policy

To provide a co-ordinated, effective and efficient response to both emergency and non emergency incidents.
