**Policy Statement**

The Civil Nuclear Constabulary (CNC), in support of its Vision and Mission Statements, and in support of law enforcement and national security, is committed to making best use of its resources and enabling its Police Officers and Police Staff to undertake specific roles and functions in planning and managing an efficient and effective response to incidents as well as the carrying out of routine and daily tasks and activities to meet legal, regulatory and contractual requirements.

To achieve this, the CNC will, as far as reasonably practicable, provide effective and efficient command and control through the provision of appropriate:-

- supervision and guidance which is informed by supporting documentation (i.e. Protocols; Memoranda of Understanding; Processes and Procedures) to effect co-ordinated and structured responses which take account of national policing standards for managing and controlling incidents and intended to achieve effective interoperability with other police forces and agencies;
- equipment to achieve reliable and dependable communications;
- training, exercising and development opportunities.

**Aims of the Policy**

The aims of this Policy are to, as far as reasonably possible, provide a structured and co-ordinated response to both emergency and non-emergency incidents and other policing activities, which will be effective and efficient and carried out in a manner which is proportionate, lawful, accountable and necessary.
