Policy Statement

The Civil Nuclear Constabulary (the Constabulary) is committed to open and transparent communications with internal and external stakeholders. The scope of the stakeholder landscape will be defined by the Community and Stakeholder Engagement Strategy.

We will adopt policies and arrangements which recognise our responsibilities to communicate with our employees. Such policies and arrangements will also extend to public openness in the operational purpose of the Constabulary to reassure interested parties that the Constabulary is fully committed to the highest standards of policing and security in the protection of the civil nuclear industry.

In giving effect to this commitment we will:

- Define and develop appropriate channels of communication to internal and external stakeholders meeting legislative requirements such as the Freedom of Information and Data Protection Acts;
- Establish proactive media strategies for reassurance and to develop the profile of the Civil Nuclear Constabulary.
- Develop a clear corporate identity for the Police Authority and the Constabulary.
- Participate in selected community events as part of the Community and Stakeholder Engagement Strategy.
