Policy Statement

The Civil Nuclear Constabulary (the Constabulary) is committed to supporting activities which deliver and enhance the Community and Stakeholder Engagement Strategy directly and it is within this framework that community events will be considered.

Under Government accounting rules funds given to the Civil Nuclear Police Authority (the Authority) have to be used for the purposes of the organisation as set out by the Energy Act. Accordingly the Constabulary has defined that:

- It may contribute to community events, such as site open days, or local shows, provided that such contribution is limited to attendance of staff and resources which will not detract from the continuing provision of the Policing Service to nuclear sites.
- Any contribution of staff and resources to community events is duly authorised by a member of the Senior Command Team and is recorded for audit purposes;
- Donations to charities and provision of financial support to community events from the Authority's funds are not permitted.

The Constabulary encourages its employees to participate as individuals in charitable events, and will consider sympathetically requests for leave to participate in such activities.

Aims of this Policy

To establish, through the Community and Stakeholder Engagement Strategy, the appropriate activities and approach for community events in which the Constabulary will commit involvement.
