## Policy Statement

The Civil Nuclear Constabulary (the Constabulary) is committed to meeting the aspirations set out in the Statement of Common Values for the Police Service. - Promote and support partnerships with local stakeholders in the areas that we operate to seek to reassure stakeholders over their security concerns and to improve our environmental performance through our Healthy & Safety and Environmental policy;
- Encourage contact with, and feedback from, stakeholders through our stakeholder and community engagement strategy to understand their concerns and seek to address these through our planning and tasking processes;
- Seek to achieve a high level of business performance delivering value for the public and company funds invested in our activities whilst effectively managing risks to the organisation and its stakeholders.

## Aims of the Policy

To reflect on and give effect to a policy for meeting the wider aims of Government and society to ensure that elements of the critical national infrastructure are appropriately protected and that such protection is provided economically, is sustainable and provided with due regard to social and environmental factors.
