## Policy Statement

The Civil Nuclear Constabulary is committed to meeting the aspirations set out in the Statement of Common Values for the Police Service. In so doing we will adopt policies and arrangements which recognise our social, economic and environmental responsibilities so as to demonstrate to our stakeholders through our statements and performance that our organisation is committed to delivering value to society at large.

In giving effect to this commitment we will:

- Set high standards and expectations for our employees to act ethically, professionally and with integrity to meet legislative requirements and public expectations for an organisation operating within the Government sector and the Police Service;
- Be open and honest in communicating our governance, policies, strategies, targets, and performance to our stakeholders within the necessary need to maintain appropriate confidentiality for those elements of national security for which we have specific responsibilities;
- Promote and support partnerships with local stakeholders in the areas that we operate to seek to reassure stakeholders over their security concerns and to improve our environmental performance through our environmental policy;
- Encourage contact with, and feedback from, stakeholders through our stakeholder and community engagement strategy to understand their concerns and seek to address these through our planning and tasking processes;
- Seek to achieve a high level of business performance delivering value for the public and company funds invested in our activities whilst effectively managing risks to the organisation and its stakeholders.

## Aims of the Policy

To reflect on and give effect to a policy for meeting the wider aims of Government and society to ensure that elements of the critical national infrastructure are appropriately protected and that such protection is provided economically, is sustainable and provided with due regard to social and environmental factors.
