Policy Statement

The Civil Nuclear Constabulary (the Constabulary) will as part of its primary role produce and maintain counter terrorist (CT) contingency plans.

The Constabulary will develop a CT exercise programme planning process in which the Site Operator, host Police Force and the Office of Civil Nuclear Security will be actively involved in a consultation process and invited to participate in the exercise in order to determine the currency, effectiveness and interaction between the agencies. Such a programme also affords an opportunity to consider all other agencies priorities and obligations in a critical or major incident

The Constabulary will deliver a counter terrorist exercise programme designed, primarily, to quality assure the tactical application and interpretation of the contingency plans.

Aims of the Policy

To ensure that the Constabulary exercises its primary purpose in the safeguarding of Special Nuclear Material (SNM), the facilities associated with the manufacture and processing of SNM and sensitive information related to the manufacture, processing, movement and storage of this material. Inextricably linked to this role is a secondary function of providing a general policing service to our customers.

To ensure that the exercise planning process of the Constabulary is a vital component of our business so that the Constabulary is able to fulfil its primary role effectively. With careful planning, effective exercise control and honest evaluation of the outcomes, it enables us to review our processes and procedures and our tactical application to ensure their currency and relevance.
