## Policy Statement

The Civil Nuclear Police Authority (CNPA) as an employer recognises that, in the nature of the Civil Nuclear Constabulary's business, we have responsibilities and obligations in relation to the health, safety and welfare of our employees, those affected by our actions and the environment.

It is the policy of the CNPA and Chief Constable to ensure as far as reasonably practicable, the provision and maintenance of:

- Safe and healthy working conditions, equipment and systems of work for all CNPA / Civil Nuclear Constabulary personnel; and
- working arrangements that reduce the negative environmental impact aspects of our operations; and
- to provide such leadership, resources, information, training and supervision as is needed for these purposes.

To this end the CNPA / Civil Nuclear Constabulary will comply with the requirements of the Health and Safety at Work Act 1974, environmental legislation, all other relevant statutory provisions and recognised codes of practice.

The Police Authority and Chief Constable expect all members of the CNPA / CNC; police officers, police staff, irrespective of rank, grade or position and all contractors working on behalf of the Civil Nuclear Constabulary to co-operate fully in the achievement of this policy.

Documents covering a statement of intent, allocation of responsibilities and particular arrangements made to implement this policy are set out in accompanying documents.

## Aims of the Policy

The aim of this policy is to demonstrate the commitment of the CNPA and Chief Constable to the health, safety, environment and welfare of our employees, the environment and those affected by the actions of Civil Nuclear Constabulary and compliance with the Health and Safety at Work Act etc Act 1974, all other relevant statutory provisions and recognised codes of practice.
