Internet Usage Policy	Date: 06/08/2009

Policy Statement

This policy relates to the use by the Civil Nuclear Constabulary (the Constabulary) of the Civil Nuclear Police Authority's (the Authority) internet access arrangements and must be read in conjunction with the Information Security Policy.

We recognise that internet facilities offer considerable benefits for employees and contractors but must be managed in accordance with the appropriate System Operating Procedures.

Internet access is available by Constabulary network account users to authorised sites subject to:

- Acceptance of monitoring and auditing of internet usage;
- User understanding that whilst internet access is provided for business use a reasonable amount of personal use is acceptable if there is no need for privacy.
- Unacceptable use definitions which are contained in the Acceptable Use of IT Policy (CNC/POL/20.5)

We will ensure that all users understand when and how the systems may be used by the underpinning procedures.

The Authority as employer reserves the right in all circumstances to disclose any information obtained in pursuance of, or in breach of, this policy to a third party for the purpose of pursuing a criminal investigation and or criminal proceedings.

Aims of the Policy

The aims of this policy and supporting procedures are to outline appropriate and inappropriate use of Authority internet resources, including the use of browsers, file uploads and downloads.
