Policy Statement

The Civil Nuclear Constabulary (the Constabulary) will maintain a number of qualified counter terrorist police search resources at appropriate locations throughout the Constabulary and by doing so we will.

- Maintain the nationally agreed standard of search and search awareness training;
- Provide advice and guidance to key stakeholders on Improvised Explosive Devices (IED), and search related issues;
- Manage search resources in support of our core business and special operations;
- To maintain close links with partners and outside agencies so as to enhance our knowledge of the current threat to our policing environment.

Aims of the Policy

The policy aims to:

- Ensure a consistent approach is adopted in respect of the management and deployment of search resources throughout the Constabulary;
- Ensure compliance with the recommendations of the ACPO Committee on Terrorism and Allied Matters on Counter Terrorist and other Search Matters;
- Ensure that police search advisors (PoISA's) are qualified to plan Counter Terrorist and other searches;
- Ensure that Counter Terrorist Police Search Team (CTPST) trained officers are qualified to conduct Counter Terrorist and other searches.
