Memorandum of Understanding	Date: 07/05/2008

Policy Statement

Memoranda of Understanding will be prepared and distributed by the Operations Support Department of the Civil Nuclear Constabulary (the Constabulary). The parties to the Memorandum of Understanding are the Chief Constable of the Constabulary, and the Chief Constables of Home Office Police Forces and Scottish Government Police Forces, in whose Force area Constabulary Operational Policing Units reside.

Memoranda of Understanding will be prepared in accordance with Home Office Circular 26/05, and the Co-ordinated Policing Protocol between the Constabulary and Home Office Police Forces/Scottish Police Forces. They are supported by Constabulary Contingency Plans and Operational Orders prepared in respect of all Constabulary Operational Policing Units.

Each Memorandum of Understanding will provide for an efficient and effective working relationship between the Constabulary and the other police force, outlining where necessary areas of responsibility and accountability. The Memorandum of Understanding will outline how the parties will usually police the places at which the Constabulary has jurisdiction. It also will make provision for consultation and co-operation between the parties, with the aim of delivering the best policing on the ground.

Aims of the Policy

To ensure that the co-ordination of operations between the Civil Nuclear Constabulary at Operational Policing Units and their relevant Home Office/ Scottish Executive Police Force in whose Force area they reside is formally agreed.
