Policy Statement

The primary function of the Civil Nuclear Constabulary (CNC) is the protection of civil nuclear sites and nuclear materials. Other functions include activities in support of law enforcement and national security as well as the carrying out of routine and daily tasks and activities to meet legal, regulatory and contractual requirements.

The CNC is committed to providing and managing its resources efficiently and effectively in order to meet its defined Mission Statement, Vision and Core Values. This will include, where appropriate, standardisation of the way in which CNC Police Control Rooms function, are resourced, equipped and managed.

To achieve this the CNC will, as far as reasonably practicable,:-

- ensure processes and guidance are available to control room staff and supervisors through Standard and Local Operating Procedures;
- assess and review control room requirements, available technology and the provision of common standards of Information Technology systems and other equipment together with appropriate support and training;
- provide control room staff and supervisors with training appropriate to their roles and responsibilities;
- ensure that, in addition to the management of routine and daily tasks and activities, structures are in place for the command and control of incidents, planned operations and notifications to the relevant Police Commanders / other key stakeholders / communities and agencies,.

Aims of the Policy

The aims of this Policy are, as far as reasonably possible, for CNC Police Control Rooms to be appropriately resourced and equipped and for control room staff and supervisors to be provided with appropriate processes, procedures, guidance and training to enable the efficient and effective management of routine and daily tasks and activities as well as the command and control of incidents and planned operations.
