Policy Statement

The Civil Nuclear Constabulary (CNC) will carry out an annual assessment / review to determine the resourcing requirements for each of the nuclear licensed sites that are protected by the CNC.

The assessment model used is known as the Standing Committee on Police Establishment (SCOPE) which uses a formula that considers a specified range of factors and calculations. The criteria and the process for the SCOPE have been agreed between the CNC, the individual Site Licensed Companies (SLCs) and the Office for Civil Nuclear Security (OCNS). The SCOPE calculations form the basis for consultations between the CNC, SLCs and OCNS to agree and approve the resourcing levels.

Aims of the Policy

The aim of this Policy is to ensure that the CNC conducts an annual process / review which will inform CNC's resourcing requirements and the minimum standards to be maintained for the protection of nuclear materials on the sites protected by the CNC to enable the CNC to effectively counter, as far as reasonably possible, the threats identified in the Nuclear Industries Malicious Capabilities Planning Assumptions (NIMCA)
