

As part of the Government Transparency Agenda, the Civil Nuclear Police Authority is required to provide information which shows:

- The extent of the organisation's establishment; and
- The salaries paid to members of the organisation's senior management.

This information provides a snap shot as at 30<sup>th</sup> September 2011 and will be updated periodically.

Narrative to support the information disclosed:

The Civil Nuclear Constabulary (The Constabulary) is a specialist armed police service dedicated to the civil nuclear industry. With Operational Police Units (OPUs) in England, Scotland and Wales, the Constabulary employs just over 1,000 police officers and staff.

The day-to-day management of the Constabulary is carried out by the Command Team, the structure of which is outlined in the organisational organogram. These roles, including that of the Executive Director, are aligned to the Home Office Chief Officers rank structure, weighting 1,

All posts within the organisation are aligned to either the Police Officer rank structure, in common with the Home Office Policing ranks from Police Constable to Chief Superintendent or the Police Staff grading structure. This structure comprises 2 levels of support staff, 2 levels of technical and advisory grades and a further 3 levels of managerial grades.

Alignment of roles is approximately as follows:
